## Upcoming Disaster Relief Funds and Grants

- The Center for Cultural Innovation (CCI) Fire Relief Fund
  - Up to \$10,000 for artists and arts workers of Los Angeles County who are affected by the Eaton or Palisades fires. **The application deadline is February 18.**

- Rauschenberg Dancer Emergency Grants
  - Dancers who have lost work due to the fires can apply for essential living expenses. **The application deadline is February 11.**
